Viticulture

85% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

Terroir: clay

Vineyard's size: 22 hectares

Vinification

Traditional, cold maceration, control of the temperatures, 3 weeks of fermentation.

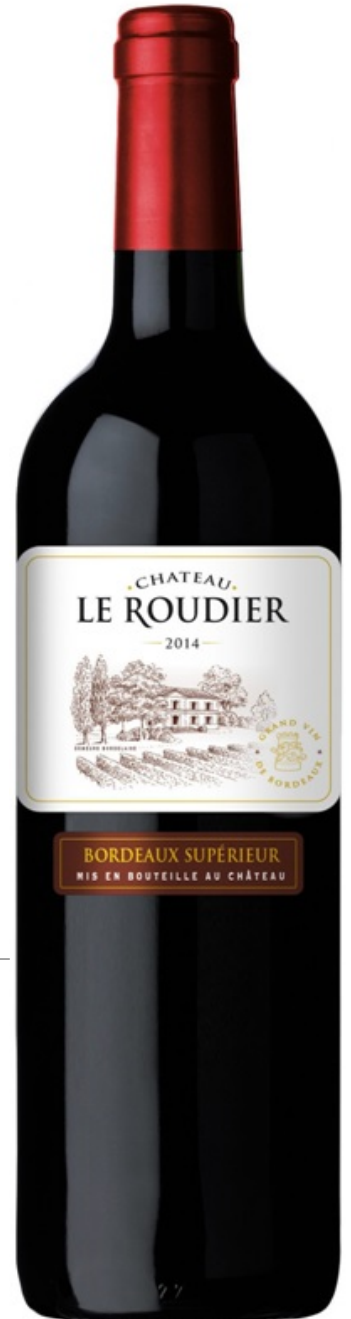
